You can choose whether or not you would like to donate your piece(s) to decorate the common spaces within the new dental school, or whether you just want your minute in the limelight. There will be a judged winner from each category, as well as a Peoples' Choice Award!

Opening date for entries: End of Semester 2, 2018

Closing date for entries: Friday 1st March, 2019

How to enter: Sign up using the online form (will be available at the end of Sem 2)

Artwork must be submitted from Mon 25th Feb - Friday 1st March 2019.

Each artist may enter a maximum of 5 works. Only those artworks created by the students or staff of the Faculty may enter.

CATEGORIES

- *Illustration/Drawing*
- *Painting*
- *Photography*
- *Sculpture*
- *Other media (bonus points for use of dental materials)*

ENTRY CONDITIONS

The following conditions must be met with each art piece entered:

1. Art work must be dry!!
2. All 2-D work that is to be sold (including works on paper, prints, drawings, collages, paintings, digital prints etc.) must be mounted or framed so that it can be hung.
3. If you are selling an original 2D artwork, it must be framed. For all copies sold, there is no frame required.
4. Art work in a frame must have hooks. If art is on a canvas, D-hooks must be screwed in.
5. If artwork is not able to be hung (3D art), it must be stated that it needs a plinth or other display requirements.
6. All pastels and charcoals must be fixed/sprayed.
7. Ceramics must be properly fired.
8. Sculptures should be of a reasonable size and be structurally viable.
9. All entries must be robust enough to withstand normal handling and display.
10. All artwork needs to be labelled on the back with an artist's name and art title. Display labels for the exhibition will be supplied by the NZDSA.
11. No label details can be changed after Friday 1st March 2019, which is the last day for artwork to be dropped off.
12. Details for artwork drop off will be provided at the beginning of the academic year.
13. All pieces must be signed in when dropped off and signed out when picked up (if not donated).
14. The NZDSA will make every effort to safeguard your item(s) and reasonable care of entries will be taken. However, the NZDSA accepts no responsibility for the loss or damage of entries.
15. By submitting your artwork, you agree to the NZDSA using photos of your artworks in promoting the exhibition and future events (credit will be given to the artist).
